4 people	Less than \$48,000
5 people	Less than \$54,000
6 people	Less than \$61,000
7+ people	Less than \$68,000

*\*Tim Hortons Foundation Camps review a combination of the Low-Income Cut-Offs (LICOs) as published by Statistics Canada and the Poverty Thresholds published by the U.S. Census Bureau to determine financial eligibility.*

- The camper was born in **2009 or 2010** (11 or 12 years of age as of December 31, 2021)  
\*if you have a camper in mind born in 2007 or 2008, please reach out for a waitlist application\*
- The camper can participate in a group setting and does not require 1:1 support
- The camper is fluent in English; all camp programming will be in English
- The camper is COVID-19 fully vaccinated a minimum of 14 days prior to their camp visit. *\*Please see vaccination policy attached and contact us directly if you have any questions\**
